Sacraments

Baptism: Baptisms are celebrated in our Parish on the first and third Sundays of the month at 12:30pm. Parents should contact the parish office at least two months before the desired date of baptism. An interview with a member of the pastoral staff and a Baptismal preparation class is required.

Confessions: The Sacrament of Confession is celebrated every Tuesday and Thursday before Mass, and every Saturday from 9:30am to 10:30am and 3:30pm to 4:30pm. You are also welcome to book an appointment with one of the priests by contacting the parish office.

Marriage: Weddings are celebrated in our Parish on any day except Sundays, Christmas, New Year's Day or during the Easter Triduum. Couples wishing to be married here should contact the parish office about one year before the desired date. Wedding dates will not be set until after the first interview with a Priest. Participation in a marriage preparation program is required.

Sacrament of the Sick: Parishioners are invited to receive the Sacrament of the Sick during a serious or chronic illness or before surgery. To arrange a time to receive the Sacrament, please contact the parish office.

FAITH FORMATION: THE DOCUMENTS OF VATICAN II

The Other Sacraments and the Sacramentals (cont'd)

- 63. Because of the use of the mother tongue in the administration of the sacraments and sacramentals can often be of considerable help to the people, this use is to be extended according to the following norms:
- a) The vernacular language may be used in administering the sacraments and sacramentals, according to the norm of Art. 36.
- b) In harmony with the new edition of the Roman Ritual, particular rituals shall be prepared without delay by the competent territorial ecclesiastical authority mentioned in Art. 22, 2, of this Constitution. These rituals, which are to be adapted, also as regards the language employed, to the needs of the different regions, are to be reviewed by the Apostolic See and then introduced into the regions for which they have been prepared. But in drawing up these rituals or particular collections of rites, the instructions prefixed to the individual rites the Roman Ritual, whether they be pastoral and rubrical or whether they have special social import, shall not be omitted.
- 64. The catechumenate for adults, comprising several distinct steps, is to be restored and to be taken into use at the discretion of the local ordinary. By this, means the time of the catechumenate, which is intended as a period of suitable instruction, may be sanctified by sacred rites to be celebrated at successive intervals of time.
- 65. In mission lands it is found that some of the peoples already make use of initiation rites. Elements from these, when capable of being adapted to Christian ritual, may be admitted along with those already found in Christian tradition, according to the norm laid down in Art. 37-40, of this Constitution.
- 66. Both the rites for the baptism of adults are to be revised: not only the simpler rite, but also the more solemn one, which must take into account the restored catechumenate. A special Mass "for the conferring of baptism" is to be inserted into the Roman Missal.
- 67. The rite for the baptism of infants is to be revised, and it should be adapted to the circumstance that those to be baptized are, in fact, infants. The roles of parents and godparents, and also their duties, should be brought out more clearly in the rite itself.

FROM THE LIONS' DEN

FOUR SIGNS THAT GOD'S LOVE IS THE GREATEST

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not perish but have eternal life."

John 3:16

Dear Family in Christ,

On this Trinity Sunday, Holy Mother Church invites us to take a closer look at something we may have taken for granted: the Love of God. St. Thomas Aquinas breaks down this passage and points out 4 ways that prove God's Love is the greatest:

- 1. 'First, from the person of the one loving, because it is God who loves, and immeasurably': God is 'that than which nothing greater can be conceived'(St. Anselm), and therefore, when He is the one loving, He does so in the greatest way. Further still, God is not simply the greatest lover- He is Love.
- 2. 'Secondly, from the condition of the one who is loved... man... existing in sin: God proves His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.' God's great love for us is proved even greater by our utter unworthiness of it.
- 3. 'Thirdly, from the greatness of His gifts': God's love is proven by action, by that which He gives. In this case, He gives not merely something, but someone- namely, His Beloved Son, His only begotten, His greatest treasure. There was no gift more precious, nothing more costly, nothing more dear to the Father's heart than His Son, whom He freely gave for the world- for you and for me.
- 4. 'Fourthly, from the greatness of its fruit, because through Him we have eternal life': God's love produces within us the greatest outcome possible- not only does it save us from eternal damnation, but because of His love, you and I have eternal life freely offered to us. There is no greater effect than Heaven.

On this Trinity Sunday, may we know beyond all doubt that the Greatest Love in the world is *ours*-not because we deserve it, but out of sheer gift. It is ours to freely accept or reject. Insofar as is possible, may we never take God's great Love for granted again.

- 8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
- 10. I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
- 12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.
