Instructions for Making Rosary Mystery Cards

- 1. Colour each of the pictures first. We will colour one each day. Use your best colouring, with realistic colours. You may use pencil crayons or markers.
- 2. Cut along the lines to separate the 5 Joyful Mystery pictures. Cut out the 5 Joyful Mystery descriptions (red). Glue each description onto the back of its matching picture. (The title below each picture should match the title on top of each description.)
- 3. Do the same for the other 15 mysteries. Be sure you colour, cut and match correctly before using the glue.
- 4. Keep your set of cards in a Ziplock bag, or have them laminated so they last a long time. You can sort them chronologically (from #1-20). Practise naming them in order and describing each with detail. This will help you meditate (think about) the mysteries when you pray the Rosary.
